Student Resource Scheme, Subject Fees & User Pays Information

Maroochydore State High School operates a Student Resource Scheme as per Department of Education guidelines. The Student Resource Scheme includes textbooks and/or educational resources that, in the absence of the scheme, would normally be purchased by the parent for the student's use at school and may include printed materials such as workbooks and worksheets, produced by the school in lieu of a prescribed textbook to enhance the student's learning experience. The scheme also supplies student and subject resources where the core curriculum is extended through provision of practical learning experiences and materials for example, art and craft supplies, cooking materials and manual arts materials.

In addition to the Student Resource Scheme this school charges User Pays Fees.

User Pays Subject Fees: Some subjects require students to use materials to fulfil assessment requirements. For example, in Art students produce paintings, in Design and Technology students design and produce a few workshop items. These projects become the personal property of students. The Subject fee is for the costs of materials used in producing these items. Additionally, some subjects require third party providers to fulfill subject or course requirements. These education service charges form part of the User Pays Subject Fee.

User Pays Activity Fee: User Pays are for external charges to the school, for example bus hire, admission costs, guest speakers and camp fees. Where a third party charges the school for the activity a User Pay fee is charged to the parents/guardians. Invoices for User Pay activities will be sent out to parents/guardians in the weeks leading up to the activity. User Pays are to be balanced for each activity and a refund must be given if the amount calculated for the refund is over \$20 per student (as per School Refund Policy, endorsed by the P & C Association).

Stationery: Personal stationery items are not provided by the school.
