



**STUDENT RESOURCE SCHEME, USER PAY SUBJECT FEES**

A Student Resource Scheme is a service provided by the school to assist parents with a cost effective alternative to purchasing textbooks, resources, consumables and/or materials from elsewhere, through reduced prices gained from the school's bulk purchasing processes. The SRS provides a convenient option that offers good value to participants and ensures participating students have access to the same standard of resources. Parents will need to provide these resources themselves if they choose not to participate in the SRS.

The school also charges **user pays subject fees (UPSF)** for activities, some consumables and excursions. These UPSF are additional to the SRS charge and are itemised against each subject.
