



**STUDENT RESOURCE SCHEME, USER PAY SUBJECT FEES**

A Student Resource Scheme is a service provided by the school to assist parents with a cost effective alternative to purchasing textbooks, resources, consumables and/or materials from elsewhere, through reduced prices gained from the school's bulk purchasing processes. The SRS provides a convenient option that offers good value to participants and ensures participating students have access to the same standard of resources.
